



Call for nominations: Careers Division Best Published Paper Award 2024

The Careers Division is pleased to announce the Best Published Paper Award for 2024. The award recognizes a paper published by a Careers Division member in the prior calendar year that contributes to the state of careers research by advancing novel ideas, challenging existing theory, and/or featuring innovative data or methods.

Eligibility:

- Papers published in print (i.e., volume and issue assigned) during the prior calendar year (2023) in recognized journals that are generally available to division members.
- At least one author must be a current member of the Careers Division.
- Papers may be self-nominated or nominated by others.

Criteria for selection:

- Significance of the paper to careers research in advancing novel ideas, challenging existing theory, or featuring innovative data or methods.
- Promise of inspiring or influencing future careers research.

Procedure:

- Submissions in a single pdf document filenamed "BPP NOM AUTHOR1SURNAME
 AUTHOR2SURNAME AUTHOR3SURNAME JNL-ABBREV YEAR FIRST FIVE WORDS OF TITLE" to
 contain:
 - A nomination letter with a full citation of the article and an explanation of why the paper meets the selection criteria (two pages maximum).
 - A copy of the full article.
- Send the document to serge.damottaveiga@neoma-bs.fr by March 15, 2024.
- A committee of well-established Careers Division scholars from multiple interest areas will
 review the applications and may themselves nominate papers for the award. The committee will
 decide the winner.
